LETTER TO ALL RECTORS AND VICARS  
OF THE DIOCESE OF EL CAMINO REAL

The Triad Companion Relationship is opening many opportunities to share in each other's lives. With the recent visit of Bishop and Mrs. Gerard Mpango, Canon Daniel Nyugwa and their team, we now have information and inspiration to help us provide scholarships for the 588 students who need financial assistance to go to secondary schools in the Diocese of Western Tanganyika. We are asking for your support of this effort.

Time is of the essence. We need to collect the funds by the end of November, in order for the students who will receive scholarships to attend when the when the school year begins in January of 2010. Enclosed are brochures, which we hope you will call to the attention of your church and distribute to leaders who will help in this endeavor. Information about this project, why there is such a need and fund raising ideas are all included in the brochure, as well as a sign-up form. Feel free to make additional copies as needed.

Individuals, families or groups within your church may wish to provide a full or partial scholarship, the details of which are in the brochure. Your church may also wish to organize a fund-raiser to provide even more scholarships.

It would be helpful if any scholarships are provided by those in your church, if you, or your delegates would bring the sign-up forms and check to Diocesan Convention on October 23rd. We will maintain a wall display to which you will be able to add one or more symbols to show your church's participation. This will encourage others to participate also.

Any scholarships provided after Diocesan Convention should be mailed directly to the Diocesan Office. All information is included in the enclosed brochures.

All God's children need to receive an education and this is a wonderful way to make a real difference in a child's life, and to let those in the Diocese of Western Tanganyika know we truly believe in the Gospel.

Bishop Mpango told of hearing his then four year old daughter at the airport asking, "Why do they have *too* much, when we don't have enough?" Let's share.
