Expectations of Adults who Accompany Youth on the Snow Trip

1. The Code of Conduct applies to all participants regardless of age. This means that:
 - a. There will be no alcoholic beverages or consumption of them at any time during the event or in transit.
 - b. There will be no use of “recreational” drugs.
2. Adults are responsible for the young people that they transport. This means that each adult will:
 - a. Know where ‘their’ children are and with whom at all times;
 - b. Do their best to make sure that the youth are involved and participating in all event activities;
 - c. Assist their young people in getting equipped for skiing, snowboarding, or snow play as is appropriate;
 - d. Be aware of any physical needs or concerns that might arise and help the young person to get those needs taken care of as is possible;
 - e. Take other such responsibility as is necessary for the safety, enjoyment, and growth of the youth in their care.
3. Adults are expected to be part of the adult leadership team for the weekend. This means coordinating with the other adults to care for all the youth that are participating in the event.
4. The adults of the event will periodically get together to assist and support one another in providing a safe and fun experience for all who attend: youth and adult alike.
5. If only one adult driver accompanies a particular youth group, *it is highly recommended*, that either that driver not ski/snowboard, or a back-up driving plan be set up by the sponsoring church in the event that the adult driver is unable to drive the group home (by reason of sprained ankle, etc.)
